

PRACTICAL DO-IT-YOURSELF SAFETY AUDIT FOR YOUR HOME

A safety audit of your home can identify areas where security can be improved.

The following checklist can be used to review your home security.

$\ \square$ Is the house number clearly visible from the street?		
☐ Can offenders be seen in the yard?		
☐ Are the front and rear doors solid core?		
☐ Are the doors fitted with a deadlock/deadbolt?		
☐ Are security screens fitted to doors?		
☐ Does the door have a door viewer (peephole)?		
☐ Are the windows fitted with key operated locks or security devices?		
☐ Are your locks keyed alike so that one key opens all doors or windows?		
□ Does the house have an automatic light timer or sensor activated lights?		
☐ Are lights left on when you go out?		
☐ Is there adequate lighting at main entry/exits?		
☐ Is there a telephone extension in the main bedroom?		
☐ Are emergency numbers keyed into the telephone?		
☐ Do you have an alarm? If so, is it always used and serviced regularly?		
☐ Is the garage/shed securely locked?		
☐ Is the meter box locked?		
☐ Are tools/ladders secure?		
☐ Is property engraved or marked for personal identification?		
☐ Has valuable property been photographed?		
☐ Have 'WARNING' stickers been stuck to windows advising that property has been marked for identification?		





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
